During the 2001 economic collapse in Argentina, the seamstresses at Brukman's clothing factory took over the operation the owners had abandoned. They reorganised it on a self management basis that is "all workers and no bosses". Brukman's went from being a symbol of worker exploitation to being a site of revolutionary labour participation. This moving documentary gets close to the participants as they struggle and suffer to put dignity into their lives. *Sit back ... and be inspired.*
